



Team Summit Colorado – Mammoth Mountain Alpine Racing Camp 2019

Dates: June 8-22, 2019

Who: All incoming Team Summit Colorado U12, U14, U16 and Ability Athletes.

Transportation: TSC vans will depart 6:00 AM June 8 for the 13 hour drive to Mammoth. Return will be June 22 at 8:00PM. Athletes choosing to fly to Mammoth Lakes, CA must arrive June 8 and may depart June 21 after 2PM

With its substantial annual snowfall and stable weather Mammoth Mountain offers some of the most reliable and highest quality late spring/early summer training in the world. An annual training site of the US Ski Team and Clubs from around North America, the Mammoth Mt. Race Department caters to visiting teams' training needs.

Lodging will be in condos and meals will be prepared home style under the direction of staff and with the help of a rotating crew of camper assistants. Athletes will learn basics of healthy nutrition, meal planning and preparation, as well as, benefit from significant cost savings.

Training is planned for 12 days on snow and is directed by TSC Alpine Ability and Age Class coaches. Focus is on fundamental technique and tactics in a high volume environment of GS and SL training. This camp builds on the stance and balance focus of May's "Keystone Area 51" Training Camp which is a critical prerequisite to maximize effectiveness of training in Mammoth.

Conditioning activities will include optional Mt. Biking on Mammoth's extensive trail network. All bikes will be transported in TSC vans for athletes who will participate in Mt. Biking activities. Alternate conditioning activities will be provided for any choosing not to Mt. Bike.

Included in camp cost are all camp expenses and round trip van transportation from Frisco to Mammoth for all athletes and equipment. Athletes choosing to fly to Mammoth Lakes, CA. will be able to send their equipment by van and will be picked up and dropped off at Mammoth Lakes Airport. Meals during travel and the day off are the responsibility of the participant.

Current valid IKON pass holders will receive a discount of \$456 of camp fees. Both 2018-19 IKON Pass and IKON Base Pass are eligible <https://www.ikonpass.com/en/ikon-base-pass>. Pass must be in possession. 2019-20 Ikon Passes will go on sale this spring and MAY include access at select resorts from purchase date forward. Stay tuned!
