March 20- 101 official end date March 21- day off March 27,28- normal training Pipe, Slope, SBX April 3,4- Normal Training Pipe, Slope, SBX April 5,6,7- Season Finale pipe, slope, SBX, and Rail Jam contests

*contests are not mandatory, kids don't have to compete in anything they don't want to compete in, no discounts for not competing.
