

COVID-19 Return to Play Plan

Athletes and Coaches are not permitted to participate in Team Summit Activities under the following conditions.

- Any symptomatic athletes or coaches may not participate in Team Summit training and activities.
- Any athlete or coach placed in quarantine or isolation may not participate in any Team Summit activities for the duration of their quarantine.
- Any athlete or coach placed in quarantine, from any source, must submit their public health letter to the Team Summit COVID-19 coordinator (RFreeman@vsortho.com), their head coach or their program director.
- Quarantine athletes and coaches will be tracked in Dragonfly

Conditions to be met for return to play:

- Any symptomatic athletes or coaches may return to Team Summit training and activities when they have been symptom-free for 24 hours without the aid of medication.
- Anyone placed in quarantine or isolation must complete the designated quarantine or isolation prior to returning to Team Summit Activities.
- Anyone placed in quarantine or isolation must have a negative COVID-19 test result, no earlier than the 11th day of quarantine or isolation, prior to returning to Team Summit activities. (Testing locations and guidelines can be found at <https://www.summitcountyco.gov/1324/Testing>)

Response to a positive test:

- If a Team Summit athlete or coach tests positive for COVID-19 their contact group and any others they have been in contact with, within 6' for 15 or more minutes in a 24 hour period will be placed in quarantine.
- Team Summit will fully cooperate with Public Health authorities in contact tracing requests.

Other COVID-19 Operational Guidelines:

- Team Summit **MAY** cancel or postpone training, without a quarantine order, if there is significant concern that athletes or coaches have been exposed to COVID-19. This could result in:
 - Canceling training
 - Canceling training for a contact group
 - Continue as normal
 - Notification of the concern and let them select to participate or opt-out
- Due to the nature of our operational structure and built-in separation of athletes and locations, it is unlikely that we would notify the entire organization of a positive test.
 - Each incidence will be handled on a case by case basis
