## 2023 Annual Report message

Welcome to Team Summit Colorado. We are a youth development organization empowering our athletes to realize and celebrate their personal podiums. Our athletes begin with a foundation of family and fun and progressively work to the excellence that defines Team Summit as a premier environment for their development.

The 2022-23 season was a year of unprecedented change in Team Summit. In November we merged with Summit Nordic Ski Club to add Nordic skiing to our comprehensive program offerings. We also launched new, low-cost, after-school programs for local elementary school students in partnership with the local towns and their recreation departments. These events continued our efforts to make our programs more accessible and helped us achieve a new record of 1048 athletes in the process. We saw three of our athletes compete in the Junior World Championships, two of our athletes were renamed to the US Ski Team, and a third athlete received their first nomination. Team Summit had more elite competitors and national champions than at any time in the organization's history.

The Team refreshed our Long Range Plan and focused our cultural and funding priorities to support critical initiatives that assure a vibrant future for the Team. Our long-term relationships with our donors and other strategic partners have fostered strong partnerships enhancing our culture of community outreach and facilitating our fundraising efforts. We also created and funded a new travel assistance program to support our athletes who have earned starts in major national and international competitions enhancing their ability to participate in events that improve their competitive status.

The Team continues in a strong financial position and through the generosity of our donors, the strength of our business relationships, and the efficiency of our operations we have been able to fully fund our capital reserve targets that allow us to invest in the long-term financial stability of the Team.

We continue to advance our culture as we Elevate Youth through our vision of whole athlete|whole team|whole community.
